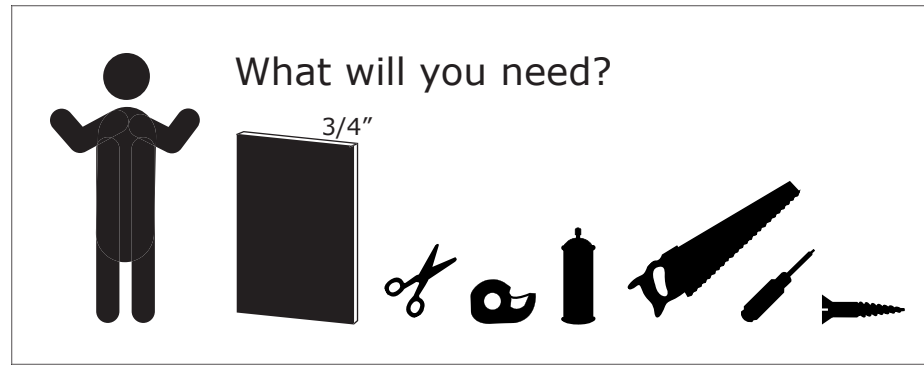
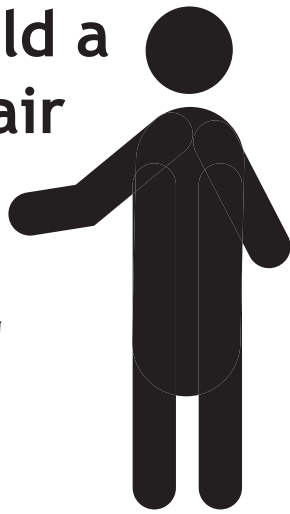
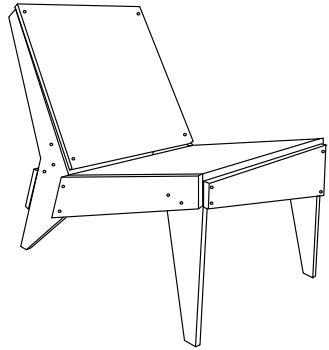


How to build a rePLY chair

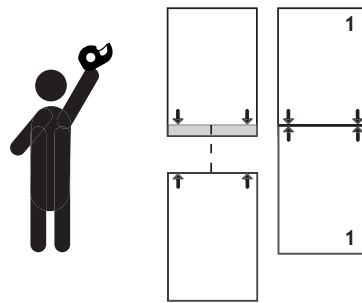

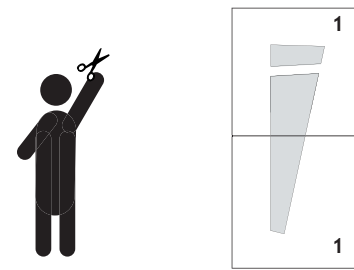
Gather scrap 3/4" plywood.

Tape each pair of papers together, match the arrows.

3



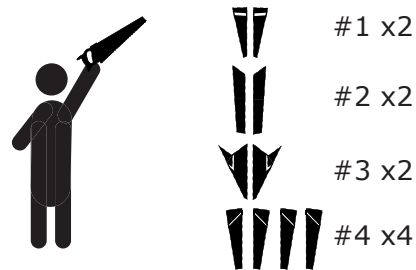
Cut along dotted lines creating the stencils.

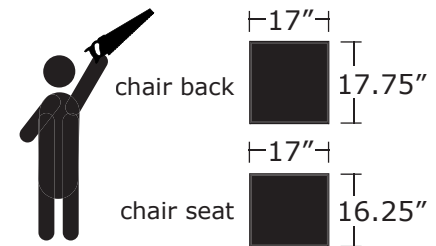
Tape stencils to plywood and spray each piece with spraypaint. Flip each stencil, tape onto a new sheet of ply and spray again (repeat two more times with #4).

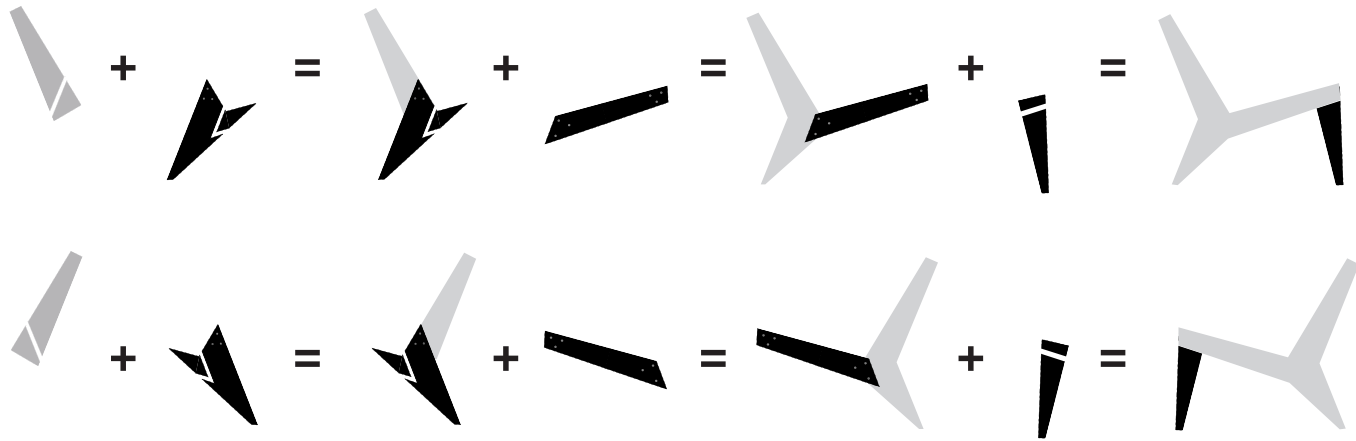
Cut out each of the pieces, the unpainted lines will be your guides when building.

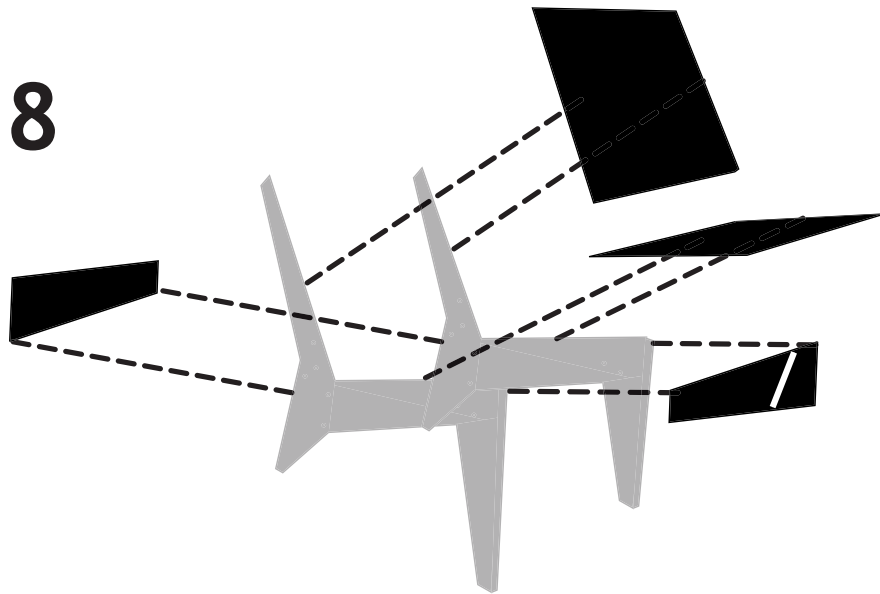
Measure and cut the chair seat and back.

Screw pieces together using the unpainted guides to align. Build one side and then the other. Each side should appear fully painted when assembled.

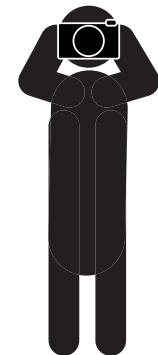
Attach braces (left over #4 pieces) to the front and back legs. Attach the chair back and seat.

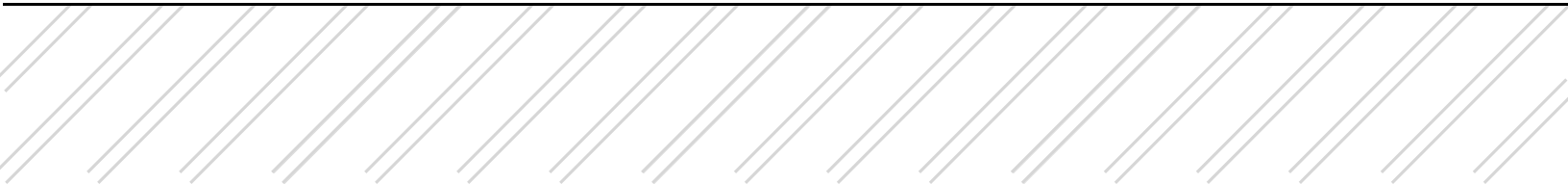
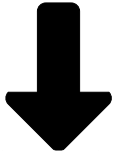
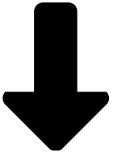
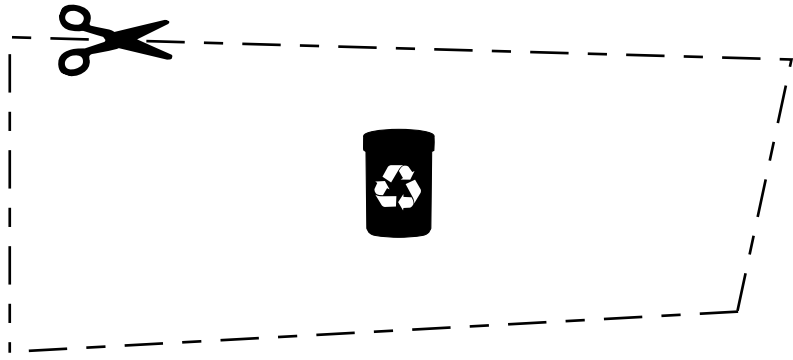


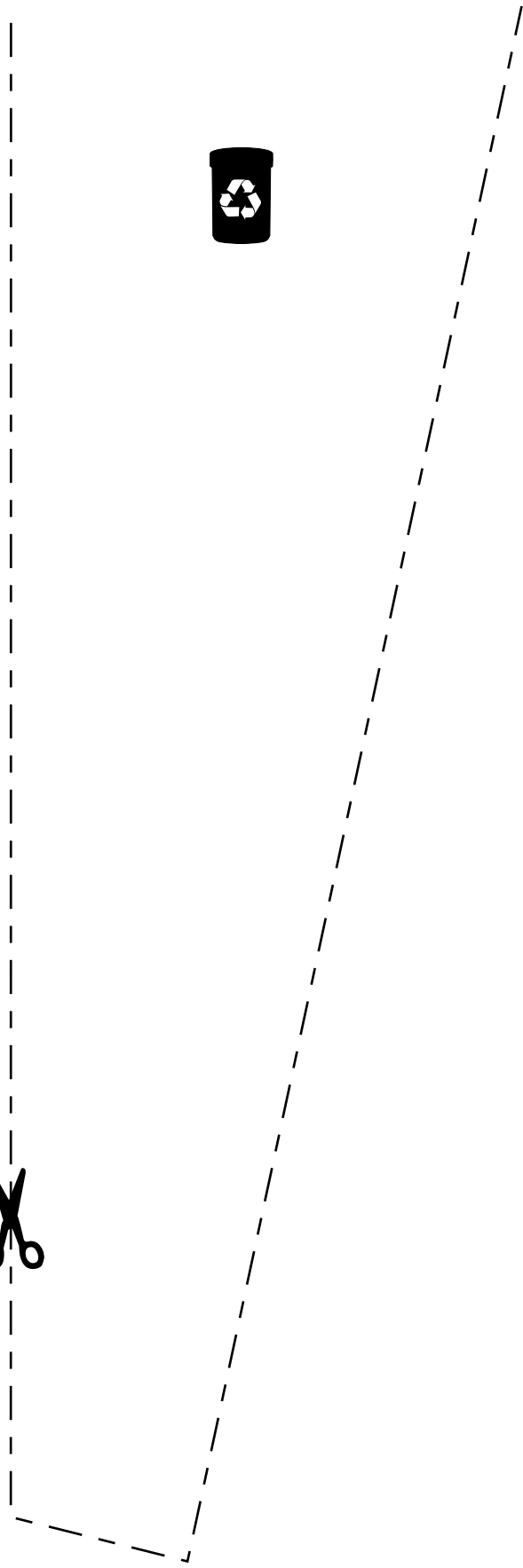
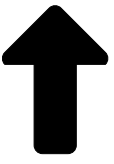
Now spray the seat and back however you like.
